Impart these values to the next generation, so that together, we can strengthen our communities, reinforce our people, and build a brighter, more prosperous future for all.

As we mark this milestone, let us not simply trace our roots but also celebrate the legacy of service that you have nurtured over the many years.

Once again, my sincere congratulations to all, especially to our awardees and every marine who has come this far.
