leadership to address multifaceted issues that surround our country today. Let all your actions reflect the core values that we all hold dear.

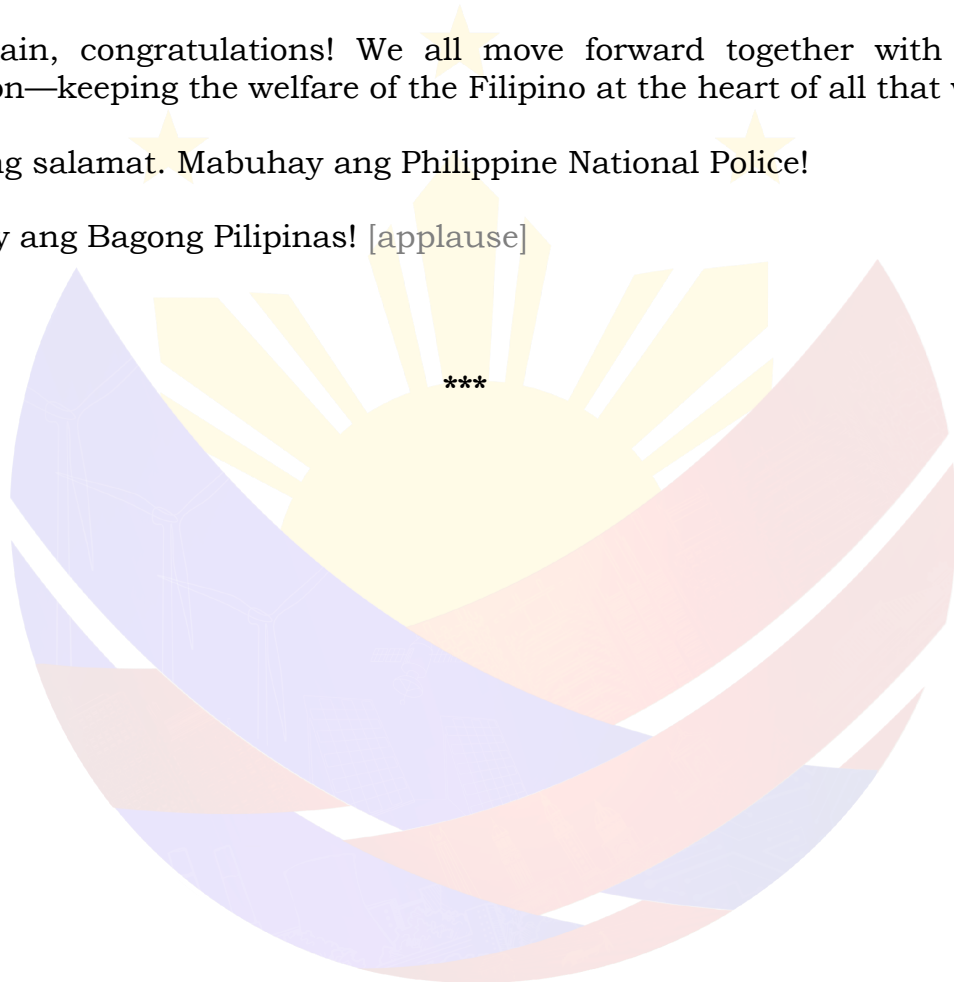
